The University of Tennessee Southern Assistant Professor/Instructor, Tenure-Track Position Mathematics/Statistics

Responsibilities:

The University of Tennessee Southern is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Assistant Professor/Instructor of Mathematics. This is a full-time position with responsibilities teaching undergraduate courses in the Mathematics program. The teaching assignment should include general education courses in Statistics, along with other general education courses and upper-level courses in Mathematics/Statistics as appropriate. Other duties will include providing service to the department, college, and community; advising students in the Mathematics program; working with students on senior projects; and participating in professional activities. Salary is competitive.

Required Qualifications:

- Earned master's degree in Statistics or Mathematics (with emphasis in Statistics) for instructorship; terminal degree for assistant professor;
- Strong commitment to undergraduate education and a desire to prepare outstanding professionals;
- Commitment to professional development and service that is consistent with the College's priorities for the Division of Math and Science; and
- Commitment to working in diverse academic and professional communities.

Screening of applications begins immediately and will continue until the position is filled. A complete application consists of a letter addressing the qualifications cited above; curriculum *vitae*; official transcripts; and the names, addresses, telephone numbers, and email addresses of at least three professional references.
